

QUAKER HAVEN CAMP

LODGES AND COTTAGES GUIDELINES

Quaker Haven has three lodges and two cottages: Friendship Lodge, Hunt Lodge, Oak Haven Lodge, Fox Cottage and Red Cottage. We like to think of Quaker Haven as a second home for our visitors, so we ask you to be responsible with the buildings, furnishings, and grounds.

We appreciate the care you put into following the following guidelines while staying at QHC.

- We request that all persons using QHC facilities be registered at the camp office located in Quaker Hall. Office hours are 9:00 -11:30AM and 1:00- 4:00pm
- Please observe the arrival and departure agreements found on your contract, as the building may be rented the same day. Arrival: 4:00pm; Departure: 2:00pm
- Bring your own linens
- The following items/activities are prohibited from use at Quaker Haven Camp: Smoking, Alcohol, Drugs, Firearms, and Fireworks.
- Quaker Haven Camp quiet time is 11PM to 7:30AM. Please be mindful of other guests.
- For the comfort and safety of all guests, we request that pets be left at home, except working dogs. Westwind Kennels is located just north of the camp entrance. 574-834-1306
- Permission to use the swimming area by non-campers is at the discretion of the camp manager. Please do not trespass on our neighbor's property as you go to the lake. Thank you.
- Vehicles are to be parked in the graveled parking areas. Boat trailers may be parked in the north Activity Center parking lot.
- Bicycles are to be ridden on roadways only. No bicycles in the cabin areas or on the beachfront.
- Tennis Courts: Only soft soled shoes. No bicycles, roller blades or skates/skateboards/or other wheeled objects.

Housekeeping: Please leave the building in neat order. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Wash Dishes** and put away
- Wipe the counters** and all spills
- Leave used linens** on counter top
- Return Furniture** to its original position
- Vacuum Carpets**
- Remove Trash** to the dumpsters located east of Friendship Lodge
- Please do not use **Red dye** drinks. We can not get stains removed from carpet/upholstery.
- Please report to the Camp Manager instances of **malfunctioning** equipment.
- Please do not use the fireplace while the air conditioning is on.** For other times, there is ample wood on the porch or wood box for the weekend.
- Fires** are allowed **ONLY in fire bowls** and designated areas.
- Leaders of groups**, as well as the members of the group, are responsible for the actions of the group and damages to the buildings, furnishings, and grounds. We reserve the right to make an additional charge for non-compliance of these guidelines.
- All Boats** are to be launched at the Dewart Lake Public Access (Lane 24) at the northwest side of the lake. See map on back →

DIRECTIONS

From the camp entrance pillars go north on Co. Rd. 500 E to Co. Rd. 1000 N and turn left (west). Follow Co. Rd. 1000 to Co. Rd. 300 E (Dewart Lake Rd) and turn left (south). Follow this road to EMS D 24 Lane and turn left again to the boat launch ramp.
